thyssenkrupp has been honored by carmaker General Motors as one of its best global suppliers. The 2015 Supplier of the Year Award went to thyssenkrupp's Springs & Stabilizers business unit based in Hagen. Performance was rated in the categories product quality, launch of new products, cost efficiency and supply chain. The award ceremony took place in Detroit in mid-March.

This year is the first time thyssenkrupp has won the coveted award as global best supplier. In the past fiscal year the company produced around three million springs and over a million stabilizers for General Motors vehicles in thyssenkrupp plants in the USA, Europe, Brazil and China.

General Motors recognized 110 of its best suppliers from 17 countries who have consistently exceeded General Motors' expectations, created outstanding value, or brought new innovations to the company. Winning suppliers were chosen by a global team of General Motors purchasing, engineering, quality, manufacturing, and logistics executives and selected based on performance criteria in Product Purchasing, Indirect Purchasing, Customer Care and Aftersales, and Logistics.

Besides springs and stabilizers, thyssenkrupp supplies the US's biggest carmaker with other chassis and engine components such as steering columns, electric power-assisted steering systems and camshafts. In addition, thyssenkrupp supplies steel for General Motors' European sites as well as engine and transmission production lines.
